

When I try to run “mdio rw” from the Myri-10G Network Adapter Tool Kit, I get “No such file or directory”. What’s the problem?

Information:

If you try to run **mdio_rw**, **myri_info**, or any other tools from the Myri-10G Network Adapter Tool Kit, and you receive the following error message:

```
# ./mdio_rw  
No such file or directory
```

The error message can occur when you try to run a 32-bit Linux myri-tools binary on a 64-bit machine and the 32-bit libraries are not installed. If you type “file mdio_rw”, it will tell you if it is a 32 bit or 64 bit binary executable. You will need to either download and install the 64-bit Linux myri-tools tarball, or install 32-bit libraries on this machine. For example, on a Debian- or Ubuntu-based system, you would need to install the ia32-libs package.
